

Historical Maps

The Historical Maps Committee preserves and popularizes the rich Canadian cartographic heritage through publication of facsimile maps. In 2014, with the support of the Executive, the committee decided to retire the Historical Map Project (no incoming series), while continuing to sell the Bird's-eye views. Two copies of each map from both series were sent to York University, as archival copies; Memorial University received the remaining inventory of the Bird's-eye views, which a representative of the committee (Dan Duda) will continue to sell until they are sold-out, at which point the Historical Maps Committee will have completed its mandate.

I'd like to thank Gord Beck, Cheryl Woods and Dan Duda for their work organizing the final sales and distribution of the map inventory. In addition, a big thank you to Gord Beck, Virginia Pow, and Rosa Orlandini for volunteering their time to organize the maps, ship them, and ensure that a copy of each is archived for posterity.

Publications Officer

The Publications Officer distributes publications (monographs) on behalf of the association and manages the publication inventories. I'd like to thank Larry Laliberté for very generously volunteering to act as Interim Publications Office for the past year - thank you! As we have seen over the past few years, demand for our publications has been in significant decline. We only received two purchase requests for books since May 2014.

Web Committee

The Web Committee oversees the maintenance of the website, its currency, design and content, as it benefits the membership. Over the past year, in addition to updating the website's content, the committee ensured that our domain and webhosting services were renewed for another two years. Thank you to the committee members for your ongoing contributions to maintaining this important communication tool.

As ACMLA moves forward with its new organizational structure, the Web Committee will be retired, and its responsibilities transferred to the Vice President Communications and Outreach, to be reimaged under a new configuration.
