

ACMLA Historic Maps Committee Report
2012 AGM

Sales were down again this year, but not as steep as last year.

There were 16 transactions with a total of 219 maps sold. Total sales valued \$1,462.35. Postage costs were \$159.82.

World of Maps is still the largest purchaser of maps accounting for 62% of the sales. The other major buyers this year were an innovation centre and a university.

We will be looking at the fees this year as the cost of postage has increased to the point that little or no profit is made on small orders.

In his report, Gord Beck thanked Susan Greaves, our former Treasurer, for her support and assistance, and welcomed Deena Yanofsky in her role as new Treasurer.

I want to thank Gord Beck for all his work he has done on this committee over the years. It is greatly appreciated.
